This method of musical instruction was created by Dr. Suzuki to simulate the way children all over the world learn their native language. Parent involvement, loving encouragement, and learning by ear before learning to read are some of the features of the method. Each instructor performing is not only a registered and trained member of the Suzuki Association, but also an accomplished musician in his or her own right. Works of the evening will include pieces by Johann Sebastian Bach, Franz Liszt, Gabriel Faure, Moritz Moszkowski, Charles-Auguste de Beriot, Robert Schumann, Samuel Barber and Zez Confrey. Proceeds of this event will support faculty training and student institute scholarships.
