## LOCAL STUDENT PERFORMS CELLO GRADUATION RECITAL

Isaac Master, age 8, performed a Cello Book 1 Graduation at Moorestown School of music recently. This was the first cello Graduation for the school. In preparation for the Book 1 Graduation, Isaac learned, memorized and polished each piece in the book as well as learned and memorized the first few pieces in Book 2. At his performance, Isaac played the entire Book 1 repertoire and topped off the performance with Bach's Minuet 2.

Isaac is a student of Kathi Stokes at Moorestown School of Music. He is a 2<sup>nd</sup> grade student of Ms. Reeve at the E.T. Hamilton School in Voorhees. His parents, Jessica and Steven Master, hosted a reception in his honor after the recital. Like the other parents at Moorestown School of Music which uses the Suzuki method to teach cello, violin and piano, one of Isaac's parents, in this case his father, comes to every lesson with Isaac and coaches his practice at home with positive encouragement and praise.
