LOCAL STUDENT PERFORMS PIANO GRADUATION RECITAL

Randall West Jr., age 14, recently performed a solo piano recital at Moorestown School of Music, filling a requirement for his Suzuki Method Book 2 graduation. Randall played 12 pieces from the book from memory, and topped off the performance with Muzio Clementi's Sonatina, Opus 36, # 1 in C Major, which is in Suzuki Method Book 3. Randall's father, who has the role of the Suzuki parent, says that, "Randall developed the discipline to practice everyday at Moorestown School of Music. This experience has expanded into other important areas of his life; academics, athletics, and his family life. He is a well rounded young man who has learned respect and a joy for learning."

Randall studies piano at Moorestown School of Music with Anne Jadwin using the Suzuki method, which nurtures the students' ability through encouragement and praise. He attends the William Allen Middle School where he is in the 8th grade.
