## **CELLO TEACHER PERFORMS AT ROBERTS SCHOOL**

The first Assembly at Roberts Elementary School for the 2008-09 school year featured Roberts music teacher and harpist Laura Dishong and guest cellist Zachary Sweet, cello teacher at Moorestown School of Music. In keeping with the Roberts School's "Word of the Month" theme, Mrs. Dishong related the word "manners" not only to every day courtesy, but also to concert manners. Mrs. Dishong (on harp) and Mr. Sweet played a duet of Saint-Saens, *The Swan* from *the Carnival of the Animals*, followed by the *Prelude* from the D Minor Unaccompanied Cello Suite by J.S. Bach played by Mr. Sweet. Children sang a song about manners and the 4<sup>th</sup> grade chorus performed a Hannah Montana song.

Zachary Sweet joined the faculty at Moorestown School of Music last month. A graduate of Eastman School of Music with both a bachelors and masters in cello performance, he is trained as a Suzuki cello teacher. He also has extensive orchestral and chamber music experience. Moorestown School of Music features lessons in cello, violin and piano following the Suzuki Method.
